Example:

A one foot run of 195 cable (diameter=0.195") will transmit 95% of a 2400MHz signal. Higher frequency signals experience more loss.

Recommendations:

- 1. Select cable with efficiency greater than 50%. For every 3dB of loss is 50% efficient.
- 2. For Small Form Factor/Low power radios (e.g. modems, SCADA radios) use higher efficiency jumpers.
