

Installation Instructions

- Drill a 25-30 mm diameter hole in the ceiling.
- Remove the backing nut and feed the pigtails through the hole one at a time.
- For ceiling tile mount, simply reinstall the backing nut and hand-tighten until antenna back is flush with the tile.
- For hard ceiling mount, two drywall anchors are included with antenna. When installing on drywall surface, follow the schematic "mounting hole size" above. For installation on other surfaces such as concrete, wood and other non-metallic, use appropriate hardware (#6 size or M3.5, 2x) to secure antenna from outside until antenna back is flush with the ceiling.
- · Installation directly on the metal surface is not recommended.
